Mayor Lane opened the meeting at 6:35 p.m.

The board reviewed various outstanding matters including zoning for smoke shop uses and dispensaries, the required lead line service inventory, creation of a Village Administrator position, the sign code, and outdoor burning.

Clerk Will suggested the board drive around the village when it is dark to determine the specific location for any additional streetlights. Once a list of locations has been determined, she will submit to NYSEG for a quote.

Trustee Roher discussed a potential summer event based on suggestions of village residents. She contacted a musician who is available in August, as well as Stella King about holding the event at Madison Hall. She will provide more information in July.
